

WELCOME BACK!

Holy Family Parish is pleased to announce the return to Public Masses with Moderate Limits on Public Gatherings and Moderate Social Distancing beginning the weekend of June 13-14. Guidelines for the return to these public Masses are listed below, and will be on the parish website and Facebook page.

PHASE II GUIDELINES:

- The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation of the Mass remains in place at this time. The faithful should use their best judgement as to whether or not to attend.
- Those showing symptoms of illness such as a cough or fever, even if not COVID related, should remain at home.
- Masks are available and strongly encouraged for all those attending Mass.
- Mass attendance will be restricted to 25% of church capacity - no more than 125 people at Our Lady of Lourdes and 100 people at St. Joseph.
- Ushers will be stationed at church entrances to help direct traffic and help maintain proper social distancing guidelines.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed near church entrances.
- The faithful are encouraged to maintain social distancing everywhere on the church property and should not congregate before or after the Masses, either inside or outside of the church.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO NOTE WHEN COMING TO WEEKEND MASSES:

- Please plan on coming to Mass earlier than you normally would. Only the front doors will be open and you may have to wait in line to enter the church as ushers will be taking temperatures and handing out face masks to those entering the church. We also need to make sure that we do not exceed the 25% church capacity at this phase of reopening.
- Temperatures will be taken as you enter church. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4°F or 38°C will be asked to refrain from participating in the Mass.
- For health protection and safety, entrance to both churches will be only through the main front doors.
- Bulletins will be handed out **after** Mass.
- To reduce the risk of contamination, we have removed Missalettes from the pews and pamphlets from the entrances of the churches.
- **Volunteers Needed!** We are looking for volunteers to read and usher at the weekend Masses. Please call the office if you would like to help in either of these areas.
- Trash receptacles will be placed by the exits for proper disposal of face masks.
- Every other pew will be closed off to help maintain proper social distancing throughout the church.
- Choir lofts and balconies are closed at this time.
- We are asking that some parishioners who normally attend the 4:00pm, 8:00am and 10:00am Masses consider coming to the 6:00pm Mass to help with the capacity limits that are currently in place.
